



Sharing Data with MicroNOC. (All data is kept confidential.)

To assist with our discovery phase for CVP (Clean Virtual Power) Service, complete the following steps below to authorize MicroNOC access to utility bills and interval data:


1. Go to: <https://user.micronocinc.com/gbsce>. You will see the SCE login request form below.
2. Enter your SCE Username and Password. Click **“Log In >”**.



3. Once logged in, you will see the following screen. Look for **“Service accounts to share data”** and click on **“Select”**.



4. Once selected, you will see site addresses in your account to connect with MicroNOC. Select each address to authorize data access by checking the box next to the address or check the “**Select All**” box. Click “**Save**” to save your selection.

5. Ensure “**Data Sharing End Date**” is set “**Indefinite**”. NOTE: You can revoke data sharing at any time in the future. Setting the end date to “indefinite”, will save you time performing the authorization while working with MicroNOC to qualify your site for Clean Virtual Power.






